Basic Line Dance: Any 32 beat song

{Wait ?? beats then Start on LEFT foot}

Part A:

Kickin Step	1	DS - K (xif) -S - DS - K
Triple Move Left	1	DS- DS - DS - RS
Push Off Turn	1	DS RS RS RS 1/2 right
Two Basics	2	DS - RS

Repeat to Face Front

Part B:

2 Triple Brushes	2	DS - DS - DS - BR-SL
2 Dbl Step-Kicks	2	DS-K-H
Push Off Turn	1	DS - RS - RS - RS
		1/2 left

Repeat Opposite Footwork

Part C:

1 Stomp Tenn. Mt.	1	Stomp - DT -H -DS -Kick
1 FancyDouble	1	DS - DS - RS - RS

Repeat 4 times to face front.

Sequence: A - B - C ----- Repeat

Rules for the Universal Line Dance: Pick your favorite 32 beat record teach the dance and Have Fun!!!!!! You could even change around and dance the routine to several different pieces of music....
